Board Members Shall Meet the Following Criteria

- A belief in Easterseals services and passionate about Easterseals mission
- Exhibit community leadership and influence
- Have interest in or knowledge about people with disabilities
- Have the ability and willingness to think, act, and speak independently with confidence and courage while fulfilling board responsibilities
- Willingness to make introductions and connect Easterseals Iowa to personal network
- Ability to meet the requirement of Office of Inspector General (OIG) and Medicaid Compliancy (see leadership application)

Board Member Responsibilities

- Embrace the vision and mission of Easterseals Iowa
- Accept and understand the by-laws of the agency
- Make an annual gift at the Presidents Council Level \$1,000 or more annually
- Attend and participate in all board meetings (4 per year)
- Attend and participate in one committee of the board
- Assist in donation procurement (cash and non-cash) \$3,000 annually
- Be an ambassador and promote Easterseals Iowa within the community

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- Attend/participate in special events
- Maintain confidentiality when appropriate
- New members ability to attend welcome orientation

The National Board of Directors Eligibility Policy applies to Easterseals Iowa. "Any team member or any immediate family member of a team member (including spouse, domestic partner or companion living in the same household, children or step-children, siblings or step-siblings, parents, in-laws, grandparents or grandchildren) of Easterseals or of any Affiliate is not eligible to serve as a director (elected, honorary or ex officio) of Easterseals or of any Affiliate."

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
